- Coronary Artery Disease

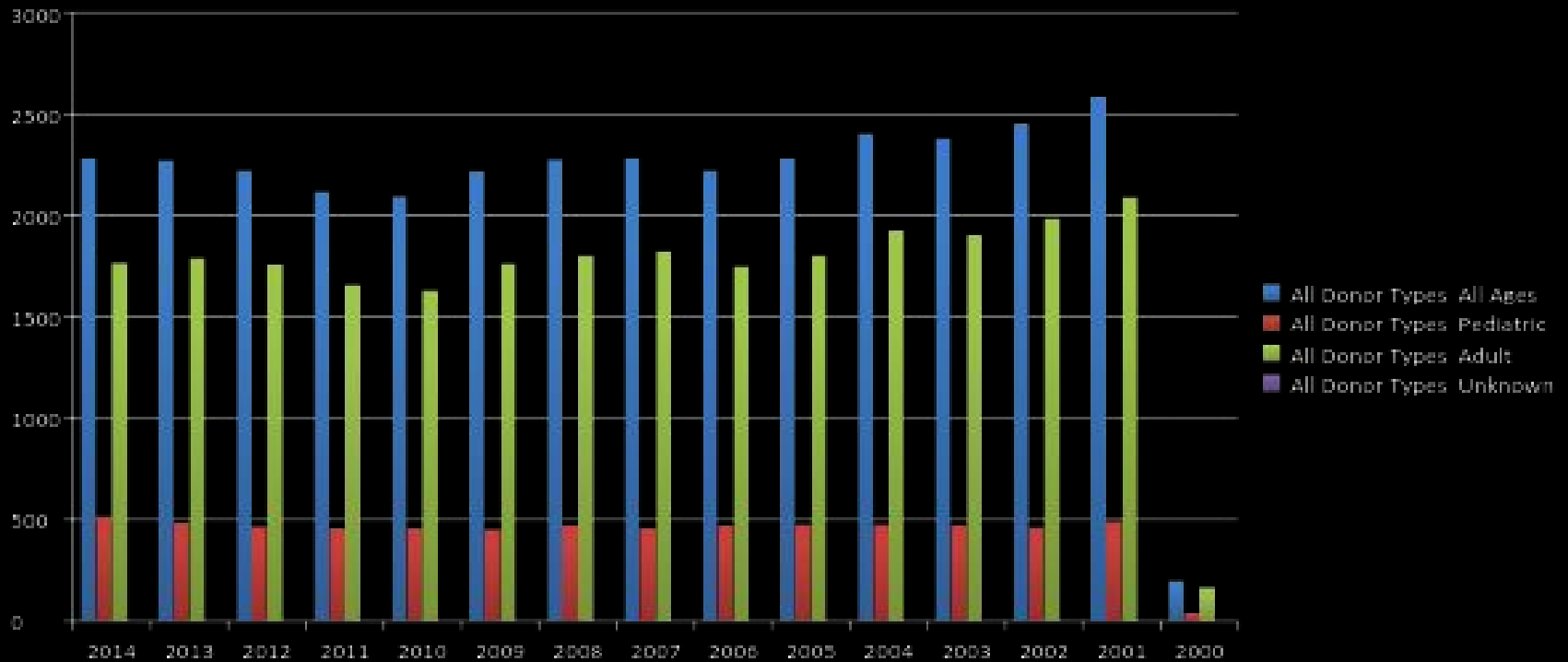
Just The Facts:

- Worldwide, about 3,500 heart transplants are performed annually
- About 81% of all people who receive heart transplants survive for at least 1 year. About 75% survive 3 years, and 68% survive 5 years. About 50% survive 10 years.

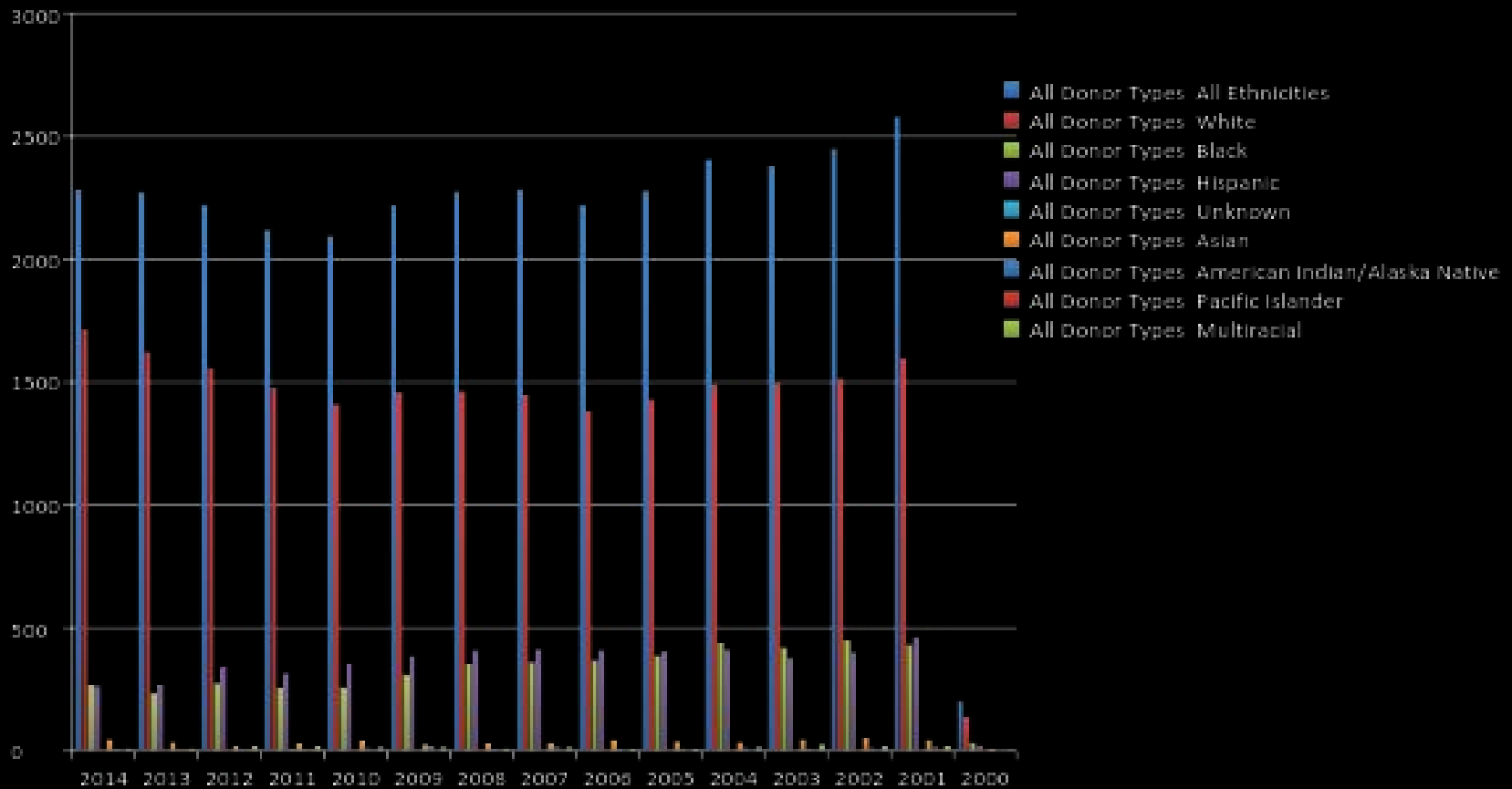
